

Agenda membership policy

This policy outlines the requirements and procedure for organisations to become members of Agenda.

Member requirements

To become a member of Agenda, an organisation must:

- Be a registered charity, registered company, or public body
- Sign up to Agenda's vision, mission, and values
- Support the overarching aims of Agenda to campaign for women and girls at risk
- Agree to support and contribute to the work of Agenda
- Agree to Agenda holding its current policy and campaigning positions
- Not pose an unacceptable risk to the reputation or operation of Agenda

Membership process

Agenda will consider requests to join from relevant organisations, as defined above. The process for joining is as follows:

- A member of Agenda staff will liaise with a representative of the potential member organisation, to ascertain that they meet the membership criteria.
- Agenda will consider the application, and inform the potential member whether or not their request to join has been accepted.
- Under certain circumstances, Agenda staff may refer a request to join to the Steering Group for consideration.
- The new member will supply Agenda with contact details for a nominated contact person, and a copy of the organisation's logo for display on the Agenda website.
- We encourage members to link to Agenda from their own website.

The final decision as to whether an organisation should be invited to join as a member rests with Agenda. Meeting the above criteria does not guarantee membership.

If a member organisation breaches one of the above criteria (i.e. the organisation acts in a way which jeopardises the achievement of Agenda's aims and values) Agenda may remove that organisation as a member.
